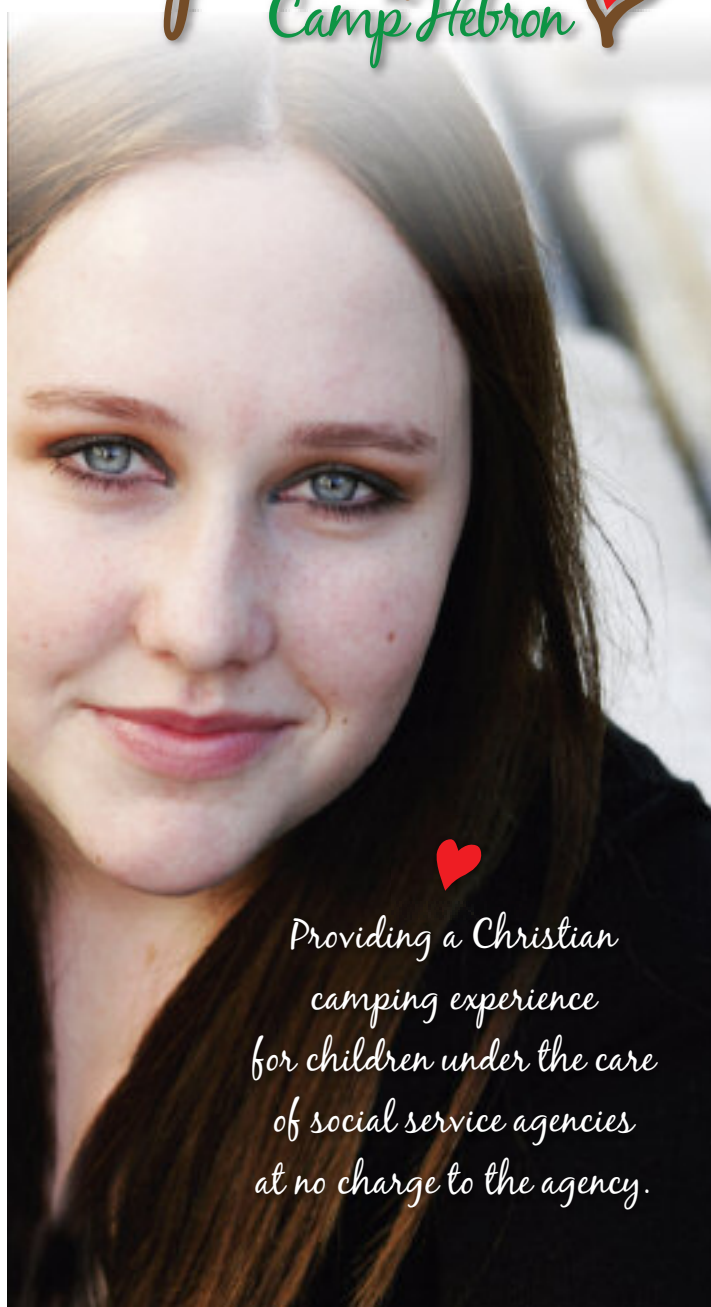

Our mission.

The purpose of Hope's Haven is to introduce abused and neglected children to the life-changing and healing reality of Jesus Christ and to help equip them to have meaningful, productive lives.



We do this through a back-to-nature, fun-filled camping experience. The children will:

- ✓ Experience Jesus and his love through the work of many volunteer counselors and staff and focused activities including worship, Bible study and campfire sharing times.
- ✓ Enjoy a rustic outdoor camping experience, sleeping in cabins, cooking over open fires and gas griddles, etc.
- ✓ Have the opportunity to participate in many age-appropriate activities which may include: hiking, swimming, crafts, games, ropes courses, climbing walls, archery and horse riding. Activities will encourage determination, perseverance, confidence and healthy self-esteem.



Our program.

At Hope's Haven, we provide the following:

- ✓ A safe, Christian camping experience exclusively for children who are current or former wards of the court.
- ✓ Carefully trained and screened volunteer counselors, who are at least 21 years of age. Our camper/counselor ratio is 2 to 1, and campers are supervised 100 percent of the time. *All counselors and everyone else affiliated with Hope's Haven has criminal history clearance and child abuse clearance.*
- ✓ A meaningful camping experience for no more than 24 children per week. We accept children 4th through 9th grades plus a retreat for returning campers in 10th through 12th grades.
- ✓ An on-site medical staff 24/7 to administer medications or address other health issues as they arise.
- ✓ Qualified lifeguards and other specially trained staff as needed, as well as junior counselors who will help with specific tasks.
- ✓ A fully insured program, insured by James O. Bower Insurance, Inc.



Our camping experience is provided free of charge, but we do have a \$5 per child registration fee. This fee can be waived in cases of need.
