Camp Basics

Requirements

We accept children who are current or former wards of the court and who live in foster or group homes in Pennsylvania. Please note that there may be a waiting list.

GRADE: Please register campers for programs based on the grade they will be going into in the fall. We use grade rather than age so the child will be in the group that they are used to functioning with. A child must be at least 8 years old to come to camp.

PHYSICAL HANDICAPS: We can take children with physical handicaps if they are able to function in a normal camp setting with no special facilities. They will need to be able to hike and walk up a fairly steep hill to their cabin. *Please call before registering to discuss on an individual basis.*

MENTAL HANDICAPS: We can take these children if they can function in one of our grade groups. We prefer that the child come to the camp with the age group that they can best function with. *Please call before registering to discuss on an individual basis.*

Returning Campers

Our goal is to have a long term relationship with children. Once a child has been to a summer camp they are automatically invited back to camp year after year, until they graduate from high school. They are invited back even if they return to live with a parent or relative.

Christian Camp

We are a Christian camp, but we are not affiliated with any church or denomination. However, we do teach biblical principles.

Location

Hope's Haven is located on the property of Camp Hebron in the beautiful mountainous area at the foot of Peter's Mountain in Halifax, Pennsylvania.

Transportation

OPTION 1: Transportation may be provided or arranged by the child's agency or county worker.

OPTION 2: Hope's Haven will provide transportation from Harrisburg, Lancaster, York, and Shamokin Dam. More pick-up/drop-off locations may be added if there are concentrations of registered campers from other areas. Drop off location will be given to the county worker assigned to the child.



Counselors

All of our counselors are volunteers. The minimum age is 21. All have been through our counselor training and have both Criminal History and Child Abuse History clearances.

Camp Activities

Swimming, hiking, crafts, cooking, non-competitive games, singing, skits, campfire program, Bible studies and stories, low ropes course, high ropes course, climbing wall.

Insurance

The camp is covered by liability and accident insurance. Information regarding policy is available upon request.

Cost and Sponsorship

The only cost is the \$5.00 registration fee which can be waived in cases of need. Hope's Haven is a non-profit organization that is supported by churches, businesses, and individuals that want to give abused and neglected children an opportunity to experience a Christian camp.
