

The purpose of Hope's Haven is to introduce abused and neglected children to the lifechanging and healing reality of Jesus Christ and to help equip them to have meaningful, productive lives.



All campers are current or former wards of the court, and most are living in group or foster homes. Hope's Haven provides these precious children an opportunity to meet the Lord through a back-to-

nature, fun-filled outdoor camping experience designed especially for them.

The campers hear about Jesus' love through worship, Bible study, verse memorization, one-on-one time with their mentors and lots of FUN! Activities include hiking,



crafts, swimming, games and much more.

The camper to mentor (camp counselor) ratio is 2 to 1, with only up to 20 children per week, creating a safe environment and the ability to provide much needed attention. Each child is



invited back each year until his the summer that they graduate from high school.
