Camp Mentor/Guide/Staff Application Information

We are blessed by your interest in the ministry of Hope's Haven. This sheet will explain our summer camp. We hope that you will be able to spend some time serving the Lord by working with us, ministering to needy children.

Our camp was founded in 2008 with the primary purpose of providing a Christian camp experience to children who have been physically or sexually abused or neglected. Our specially designed program is focused on building relationships through which healing, direction, and purpose through Jesus Christ can come into their disrupted lives.

The uniqueness of this camp is centered upon giving children a real outdoor experience with lots of opportunity for one-on-one contact with mentors. We have a ratio of one mentor for every two campers. During the summer, the children learn of practical Christian servanthood and love through crafts, hiking, swimming, games, campfires, singing, and of course, Bible studies, Bible stories, and Bible teaching. The program is informal and family oriented.

Our program is designed to lead an unbeliever to accept Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and to help a believer to commit his/her life to following the guidance of God's Word through the leading of the Holy Spirit. We emphasize prayer, Bible study, and the discussion of relevant life topics. There is lots of opportunity for one-on-one mentoring, which is key to building the relationship of truth that is necessary to turn a child to Christ.

We are able to provide this program free-of-charge to needy children, because we have no paid camp staff. We ask all of those who work at the camp to volunteer their time, because we consider our staff to be short-term missionaries. There is no cost for you other than your personal belongings and transportation. All camp costs are covered by donations.

Now, where do you fit in? During the summer, we need camp staff that can spend at least four days with us. If you're able to serve more than one "week" of camp, that's great. Our June are held at Camp Swatara in Bethel, PA.

What about qualifications? We require our camp staff to be committed Christians with a personal testimony of Jesus Christ's leading in their lives. In addition, they must have the desire and ability to lead a child to accept Jesus Christ as personal Lord and Savior. It has been our experience that this mission-minded camp setting can be overwhelming to a new believer. Therefore, we ask that our mentors and guides have been Christians for at least two years. Mentors need to be at least 21 years old, and guides, at least age 16. We also ask everyone to commit to reading the Mentor or Guide Training Handbook and attend staff training. The only additional requirement is a sincere desire to work with these hurting children. (Job descriptions are on the next page.)

Before you decide, we suggest you read our brochure or check out our Web site to give you a better idea of our ministry. In addition, please make your decision a matter of prayer. Ask the Lord to guide you and show you if this is His will for you. If the answer is "yes," please fill out the application, and send it to us right away – March 31st at the latest. The number of staff that volunteer directly relates to the number of campers we can accept. The sooner we get applications in and approved, the sooner we know how many children can come to camp. After receiving your application, we will contact your references, and then call you to set up a personal interview. We also require background checks. If your decision is "no," we understand. Please, pass along these materials to someone else whom you think might be interested.

Camp Staff Ministry Descriptions

<u>Guide</u>: Hope's Haven camp guides are individuals age 16 and older who act in a supportive role to the camp mentors and other camp staff. In addition, their job is to have fun with campers and build relationships with them, showing them what an authentic relationship with Jesus Christ looks like.

<u>Mentor</u>: Hope's Haven camp mentors are individuals **age 21 and older** who are responsible for 1 to 2 assigned campers for the camp week. Mentors look after the health, safety, emotional, and spiritual welfare of their campers. They spend time with their campers, building a mentoring relationship with them. They teach their campers about biblical principles and life skills throughout the day, and the show them, by example, how to live out an authentic relationship with Jesus Christ.

Other:

- **RN:** A registered nurse is required for each camp. The nurse is responsible for the health of the campers and completion of required documentation. The nurse is required to stay during the entire 4-day camp.
- **Photographer:** Camp Photographer is a vital part of the camp experience for our campers as well as a necessary tool for promoting camp on our website and during speaking engagements. Photographers are expected to attend all camp activities to get the best possible pictures of both the staff and campers. The photographer is required to stay during the entire 4-day camp.
- **Kitchen:** The kitchen staff takes direction from the camp cook. Their responsibilities include duties necessary for meal and snack preparation. It is preferred, but not always required, that the kitchen staff stay during the entire 4-day camp.
- **Support Staff:** Support Staff can either be a day-only (stay at camp during the day and go home at night), or overnight (stay during the entire 4-day camp). Support Staff are there to **assist** in supervising campers during meals, activities and free time. Support Staff are also assigned responsibilities that help with various activities, as well as set up and clean up of camp.

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Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Background Clearance Requirements

In order to provide a safe environment for the children at Hope's Haven Camp, and in accordance with Pennsylvania Law, the following forms and signatures are required for all staff ages 18 and older.

Hope's Haven requires that all new staff apply for a new Child Abuse Clearance and Criminal Record Check.

1. Child Abuse Certification

You can apply for your clearance at https://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis/public/home. Create an Individual account and provide necessary information. Clearances for volunteers if free-of-charge. If you need any assistance with obtaining this clearance, please contact us.

- 1. <u>Criminal History Check</u>. Hope's Haven will complete this record check for you based on the information provided in this application. A completed clearance will be provided to both Hope's Haven and sent to the email you provided on this application.
- If you are NOT a resident of Pennsylvania, or have not been a resident <u>continuously</u> for the past 10 years, a
 Federal FBI fingerprinting is required every three years. You need to register at the Department of Human
 Services https://www.pa.cogentid.com/index.htm. This is not free. In addition, we will need a Criminal
 History Check and Child Abuse Clearance from your state of residence. These clearances are required by April
 30, 2021.

EXPECTATIONS FOR HOPE'S HAVEN CAMP STAFF

- 1. Come to camp spiritually prepared and physically rested.
- 2. Put the needs of the campers above your own.
- 3. Spend more time interacting with the campers than socializing with other staff.
- 4. Participate in all camp activities with assigned campers and your camp team, such as games, clean up, and Bible stories.
- 5. Encourage growth in your campers, realizing that every camp activity is a learning opportunity.
- 6. Respect the authority of the staff over you.
- 7. Perform duties as assigned by the camp director.
- 8. During activities, such as meals, pool, and games, help to supervise all campers (as well as your assigned campers).
- 9. Make sure you and your assigned campers are on time for scheduled activities.
- 10. Mentors Sleep in the same cabin with your campers, if they are the same gender as you.
- 11. Be ready to share a 3-5 minute testimony.
- 12. Help to keep the campsite area clean.
- 13. Be enthusiastic and have fun!

I agree to hold all information regarding campers <u>confidential</u>. I will not relay any camper information, including camper names, to anyone outside of the Hope's Haven camp. Breaching this agreement may result in my inability to serve as staff in the future.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

It's everywhere. Everyone is vulnerable. We must pro-actively address it.

- In a survey by pastors.com of more than 5,000 pastors, more than 55% had visited a
 pornographic website within the year, and 33% had visited a sexually explicit site within the
 previous three weeks.
- A Focus on the Family survey showed that 1 in 5 Americans have visited sexually oriented sites.
- Nine out of ten of the 500 men attending a church retreat in California indicated that lust, porn, or fantasy was the habitual, continual, and fatal disconnecting factor in their relationship with God.
- Six out of ten highschoolers have had sexual intercourse. The latest trends, even in churched teens, shows most endorse "dirty dancing," group sex, "friends with benefits" a kind of non-committal relationships for having sexual favors or "messing around," and the like.
