

Camp Staff Ministry Descriptions

<u>Guide</u>: Hope's Haven camp guides are individuals age 16 and older who act in a supportive role to the camp mentors. In addition, their role is to have fun with campers and build relationships with them, being a friend and a Christian role model. They are under the guidance of the Camp Directors.

<u>Mentor</u>: Hope's Haven camp mentors are individuals **age 21 and older** who are responsible for 1 to 2 assigned campers for the camp week. Mentors look after the health, safety, emotional, and spiritual welfare of their campers. They spend time with their campers, building a mentoring relationship with them. They teach their campers about biblical principles and life skills throughout the day. They under the guidance of the Camp Directors.

RN: A registered nurse is required for each camp. The nurse is responsible for the health of the campers and completion of required documentation.

Photographer: Camp Photographer is a vital part of the camp experience for our campers as well as a necessary tool for promoting camp on our website and during speaking engagements. Photographers are expected to attend all camp activities to get the best possible pictures of both the staff and campers.

Kitchen: The kitchen staff duties include all necessary preparations for meals and snacks. They are under the direction of the Camp Cook.

Support Staff: Support Staff are there to assist in the day to day set up of crafts, games, and activities. They are the ones who help camp run smoothly while doing the 'behind the scenes' duties as assigned by the Support Staff director.
