Transportation Options:

- 1. Child's parent/guardian provides transportation to and from camp.
- 2. The child's agency or caseworker may provide or arrange the child's transportation to and from camp.
- 3. Hope's Haven will provide transportation from Harrisburg, York, Lancaster, and surrounding areas. Hope's Haven staff will confirm the pick up/drop off location with the child's parent/guardian a few weeks before camp.

Requirements:

We accept kids, grades 4 and up, who are or have been in foster care. They may live in foster homes, group homes, or with their adopted or biological parents.

Grade:

Please register campers for programs based on the grade they will be going into in the fall of 2021. We use grade, rather than age so that the child will be in the group with which he/she is used to functioning.

If you have a child with a disability, we invite you to contact us to discuss oppertunities to see if camp is suitable for your child.

Christian Camp: Hope's Haven is an overnight Christian camp that teaches biblical principles. It is not affiliated with any denomination or church.



Camp staff: All camp staff are volunteers who have been through our specialized staff training, and have the necessary Criminal History and Child Abuse background clearances.
