Hope's Haven provides these precious children with an opportunity to meet the Lord through an outdoor summer camp experience designed especially for them.

The campers hear about Jesus' love through worship, Bible study, verse memorization, time spent with camp Mentors, Guides, and staff, and lots of FUN! Activities include hiking crafts, swimming, games and much more.

The entire camp experience is provided at no charge to the child or agency and is funded by churches, individuals, groups and businesses that support the mission of Hope's Haven. (The estimated cost per camper is \$600.)

Staff Roles

Mentor: Ages 21 and older who are assigned 1 or 2 campers for the duration of camp. Mentors are caring adults who build relationships with the campers by participating in camp activities, giving encouragement, helping the campers in their relationship with Jesus, and having fun!

Guide: Ages 16 and older who are assigned 1 or 2 mentors for the duration of camp to support the mentors. Guides are caring teens who build relationships with the campers by participating in camp activities, being a Christian peer role model, and having fun!

Support Staff: Ages 16 and older, who support directors by setting up and tearing down activities, interacting with campers during activities, and help to keep camp running smoothly.

Kitchen: Ages 16 and older, who helps to prepare meals and snacks at camp, and are involved with the campers when available.

Nurse: RN or higher, who is responsible for administering medications to campers and treating minor injuries. (We cannot have camp without a nurse!)

Photographer: Ages 16 and older, who takes photos during camp and creates a slideshow for the campers to view on the last day of camp.
