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CAMP THEME VERSE

1 Chronicles 16:11 Look to the Lord and His strength; seek his face always.







Group Bible Study Day 1 - Perseverance

REVIEW BIBLE VERSE

- Say: Daniel was around 13-15 years old when he was taken captive. They had everything going for them
- Camper read Daniel 1:3 What kind of background did the men have?
 - Then the king ordered Ashpenaz, chief of his court officials, to bring into the king's service some of the Israelites from the <u>royal family</u> and the <u>nobility</u>
 - Ask: What do you think their lives were like, living in a royal family?
- Camper read Daniel 1:4 What kind of men was the king looking for?
 - young men without any physical defect, handsome, showing aptitude for every kind of learning, well informed, guick to understand, and qualified to serve in the king's palace. He was to teach them the language and literature of the Babylonians.
- Say: Then they were removed from their family and their land.
 - The life they knew as part of the royal family was gone.
 - o Their names were changed.
 - They were told that the rest of their life would be as servants of the king
- o Camp Handbook: Camper or Staff read definition of PERSEVERANCE.
 - Ask: Has there ever been a time when that happened to you? Where you continued doing something even though it was hard, or someone said you couldn't? (Mentor: Have a story from your life ready to talk about, if needed.)
 - Camper read Galatians 6:9 and fill in the blanks in their Camper Handbook.
 - Say: Daniel wanted to eat vegetables and drink water. There were certain foods they were not supposed to eat that the King wanted them to eat.
 - Ask: What happened to Daniel and his friends when they are only vegetables?
 - o Camper Read: Daniel 1:15
 - At the end of the ten days they looked healthier and better nourished than any of the young men who ate the royal food.
- o Say: After he was taken captive, Daniel had a choice.
 - He could fight, and he could be angry. But instead, he followed what he thought God would want him to do.
 - What did God do for Daniel, Shadrach, Messchach, and Abednego?
- o Camper Read: Daniel 1:17 and fill in the blanks in Camper Handbook.
 - To these four young men God gave knowledge and understanding of all kinds of literature and learning. And Daniel could understand visions and dreams of all kinds.
 - **Say:** Daniel didn't know it yet, but God gave him these abilities for a specific reason, which you will learn more about tomorrow.
- o If you could have any ability, what would it be and why?
- If time, look up Galatians 6:9 and fill in the blanks in Camper Handbook.

To persevere means: To do something even though it is hard, and to keep doing it even though you may fail or others may tell you that you can't.

Group Bible Study Day 2 - Wisdom & Strength

Have an arm wrestle competition, trying to pair people up that are similar in strength. Have the non-participants cheer on the others. (If you find that all the campers are cheering on one particular participant, have some staff cheer for the other participant.)

How can you tell if someone is strong?

- Allow campers to explore different types of strength: Physical, mental, and emotional
- How does our society view people that appear to be weak: Physical, mental, emotional

Camper Read: 2 Corinthians 12:10 (This is the apostle Paul writing to the Corinthians.

- "That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong."
 - Ask: None of us likes to be insulted and persecuted. How do you think you would respond if someone was making fun of you and insulting you?
 - Answer: Paul is saying that when we follow Jesus, sometimes people will say
 we are weak or foolish and insult us. When we go through these hardships, we
 may feel weak. But we are strong because Jesus gives us the strength we need
 and we can find contentment in living our lives for Christ.

Camper Read: 1 Corinthians 16:13-14 and fill in the blanks in Camper Handbook.

- Be on your <u>guard</u>; <u>stand</u> firm in the faith; be <u>courageous</u>; be <u>strong</u>. ¹⁴ Do everything in <u>love</u>.
 - Say: There are different kinds of strength. We started out by talking about physical strength. But here, God is talking about spiritual strength. And He ends the verse by telling us to do everything in love.
 - Read: Paragraph under verse in Handbook.

REVIEW BIBLE VERSE

Camper Handbook: Read the paragraph about training.

Say: Let's talk about wisdom. In yesterday's Bible study we learned that Daniel was obedient to God, and God gave him something in return. Does anyone remember what it was?

- Answers: Knowledge, Understand, Ability to interpret Visions and Dreams
 Camper Handbook Day 2:
 - In the Bible, wisdom means that we understand life from God's perspective, not our own.
 - In our story today, Daniel thanks God for giving him wisdom and strength.
 - Camper Read: James 1:5 and fill in the blank in the Camper Handbook.
 - If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask <u>God</u>, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.
 - What is the first step in getting Wisdom?
 - Camper Read: Proverbs 9:10 In this verse 'fear' means 'deep respect, awe, reverence'. You need to have reverence for God to get wisdom from God.



Group Bible Study Day 3 - Courage & Trust

Review Bible Verse

Camper Handbook – Read about Fear and Trust and the Bible verse that is in Handbook.

- As if anyone (including staff) ever had a time that they trusted someone only to be let down?
- After everything that Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego had been through, what people do you think they trusted? (Possible Answers: No one, only each other, God)
- Shadrach, Meschach, & Abedinego were able to trust God completely. The trusted him even through this scary situation. Why can we trust God?
- Camper or Staff Read: Matthew 6:25-26
 - Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? ²⁶ Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?
- **Ask**: Why do you think God tells us NOT to worry?
 - We are supposed to trust in God, so when we worry, we are not trusting in Him.
- Ask: If we find ourselves worrying, what can we do? (Possible Answers: Go for a walk, pray, talk to a friend)
- Camper or Staff Read: Philippians 4:6 and fill in the blanks in Camper Handbook.
 - Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
- Ask: How many of you carry around heavy backpacks filled with books? (If you want to prepare for this study, fill a backpack with books that you will take out during discussion.)
- **Say**: Worry is like that heavy backpack. You are trying to lug around all these heavy burdens and fears. (**Start unloading books.**)
- Ask: When you take your heavy books out and carry the backpack almost empty, how
 does it feel now?
 - (Possible Answers) Light, easy to carry
- Camper or Staff Read: Matthew 11:28 and fill in the blanks in Camper Handbook
 - Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
- Ask: God wants us to come to him when we are having a tough time. Have you been worrying about things? How does worrying make you feel physically and emotionally? (Allow answers)
- **Say:** Trusting God makes us feel comfort and peace.

Close in Prayer
